

Senior Privilege

To promote the development of independent life skills of balance of work and self care, planning and organization and prioritization and time management Stoneham High School permits Senior Privilege for eligible Seniors. Senior Privilege has been approved for the Class of 2022 by the School Committee for the 2021-2022 School Year.

Privileges include the ability to leave school grounds during lunch and Flex Block.

- Students will sign in and out through the QR code system as they currently do for PE Independent Study, Work Study or Internships.
- The Senior Privilege option to leave school grounds during FLEX on days 2, 4 and 5 will require that they register in advance on the preceding Day 1.
 - Teacher requests to meet with a Senior will override a senior privilege sign up.
- Minimum requirements for eligibility is passing of all classes, in good behavioral standing and a parent / guardian signed permission form.
 - Administration holds the right to limit privilege as situations arise.
- \bullet Senior Privilege will be active starting with the 10/25 Flex Cycle
 - 1st day of Senior Privilege is Tuesday, 10/26; Day 2

A Senior Class meeting will be held on Friday, 10/22, to review expectations and details with Seniors. Please be on the lookout for Senior Privilege Permission Form which will be available to seniors on 10/22.
